



Grand Overview of VOMI Global Think Tank & Advisory Board

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I. Why a Global Think Tank AND Advisory Board?

- We have no other choice, our mission to spread the Luminous Light of VOMI to every single individual in every corner of the globe requires it.
- We live in a Complex World with Complex Systems and Multiple Silos of Interest which have a great need to learn more about our Universal Message on the benefits of Virtual Organization Management.

- A Place for you to Begin to Gradually Experience “Virtual Organization Management” for Yourself, albeit in a very limited fashion and relaxed environment , Live and In Color.

II. Membership Levels & Duties of the Board

Membership Levels

We have 4 different membership levels and they are as follows:

1. Active Member

These members are active members of the board; primarily operate, but not exclusively, in the capacity of committee chairs and vice chairs and as regular and alternate members of committees; play a very significant and active role in the development and success of the board; and are allowed to participate in **highly sensitive, top level, secret and/or top secret** engagements or assignments subject to obtaining the necessary and proper clearances.

Requirements: Unless a member has formally received from the Chairman of VOMI Global Think Tank and Advisory Board an Active Member appointment to a specific board position on an interim basis (an “Interim Appointment”), then each active member must: **1)** have successfully completed prior service as an Interested Member for a minimum of 3 months; **2)** have either received a (i) recommendation for nomination from their current Committee Chair, or (ii) a formal nomination from the Executive Committee of the VOMI Board of Directors (the “VOMI Board”) or the Nomination Committee of the Think Tank Advisory Board; **3)** currently hold a U.S. government

secret clearance or be able to pass a U.S. government or corporate background investigation in order to participate in highly sensitive projects that are either of a national security or highly confidential nature or which may be subject to the Export Control Laws and Regulations of the U.S. government; and **4)** be duly elected to the Board in accordance with its charter and subject to formal ratification of the appointment by the VOMI Board.

Benefits: Active Members are eligible to receive significant VOMI equity grants, cash compensation, future appointment to VOMI executive leadership team positions, including the corporate VOMI Board of Directors, and other high-value company benefits, including **full** scholarships and fellowships.

2. Interested Member

These members are allowed to participate in **non-sensitive** committee assignments for very brief and limited time periods when the need arises, subject to their availability and capabilities and upon the approval of their respective Committee or Subcommittee Chair.

Requirements: Prior successful service as an **Observer Member** for a minimum of 3 months as well as formal appointment by a respective Committee Chair.

Benefits: Interested Members are eligible to receive significant cash compensation and other company benefits, including scholarships and fellowships, and free or heavily discounted services to their respective organization.

3. Observer Member

These members are restricted to participation in general meetings strictly in an observer and learning capacity. Extensive participation in highly engaging interactive discussions and providing feedback is highly recommended.

Requirements: Successful participation in a minimum of 5 committee meetings as an **Auxiliary Member** and a Committee Chair's approval. Prior verified participation in 2 VOMI paid events can be substituted in lieu of the latter requirement.

Benefits: Observer members are eligible to receive various company benefits, including heavily discounted services to their respective organization.

4. Auxiliary Member

These members are invited guests of the Board and have no formal or official status within the VOMI Global Think Tank and Advisory Board. They are, however, considered members of the Main VOMI Membership Body and, therefore, eligible to participate in general meetings of the board, *upon invitation*, as well as being able to vote for official candidates of the Think Tank-Advisory Board during election time.

Requirements: Automatic membership as an **Auxiliary Member** is granted to all members of various **VOMI** social networks and to all individuals who have positively responded to our invitation to (i) obtain a grand overview of the VOMI Global Think Tank and Advisory Board or (ii) to join the Board.

Benefits: Auxiliary members are eligible to receive discounts on company events.

Automatic Virtual Organization Board Residency Program for All New Members

All new members are automatically enrolled as Auxiliary Members.

All members who have expressed an interest in going beyond this initial membership level will be automatically placed in an informal virtual organization board residency program based on their initial submission of interest in a preferred committee position, as submitted to us in accordance with the instructions below at **Section V – Next Steps**.

Upon meeting each set of requirements for successful participation at a higher designated membership level, each member will be automatically nominated by their respective committee chair for the next membership level until the member reaches his/her preferred committee position and destination.

Duties of the Board

Duties of the Global Think Tank and Advisory Board include:

- (a) Act as an advisory organ to the Office of the Chairman on matters pertaining to local, regional, and international issues, events, and opportunities.
- (b) Assist with review and adoption of corporate governance rules.

- (c) Function as the research and education arm of VOMI focused on bringing to the attention of world leaders and the public at large the impact of virtual organization management on global issues of government, politics, economics, law, defense and foreign policy, education, culture, health care, social welfare, and other relevant and pressing issues of the day.
- (d) Hold hearings on a weekly, monthly, quarterly or ad hoc basis and make recommendations to the Executive Committee of the Board of Directors on matters of strategic importance and relevance to both the short- and long-term success of VOMI.

III. Compensation & Benefits

Over 54 million performance share units and restricted stock units have been allocated for compensation to **Active Members**.

Committee chairs are eligible to receive **up to a combined total of 1 million** performance share units and restricted stock units over a maximum 3-year term period. As well, committee chairs will have an opportunity to have awards, scholarships, fellowships, and education departments named in their honor in recognition of their significant contribution to the board, VOMI and the global community at large.

Committee vice-chairs are eligible to receive **up to a combined total of 500,000** performance share units and restricted stock units over a maximum 3-year term period.

Subcommittee chairs are eligible to receive **up to a combined total of 250,000** performance share units and restricted stock units over a maximum 3-year term period.

Subcommittee vice-chairs are eligible to receive **up to a combined total of 175,000** performance share units and restricted stock units over a maximum 3-year term period.

All **regular** and **alternate members** will be eligible to receive **up to a total of 50,000** restricted stock units over a maximum 3-year term period.

Ad Hoc Cash Compensation is also available to all committee chairs and vice-chairs, as well as all regular and alternate members, on a performance basis and such award shall be based on the value of

tangible revenue opportunities brought to VOMI by a member in an individual capacity or while acting in concert as a group. The exact computation of such amount as well as all other benefits shall be based on a formula determined in advance by the finance and compensation committee of the think tank-advisory board.

Think Tank-Advisory Board members with a significant track record of performance will receive priority consideration for recommendation and/or appointment to the Board of Directors of VOMI and other leading executive officer positions.

All board members are also eligible for non-cash benefits in the form of grants, scholarships and fellowships, free or heavily discounted services to their respective organization, as well as other benefits. Such benefits shall also be determined by the compensation committee subject to the approval of the executive committee of the think tank-advisory board and ratification by the executive committee of the Board of Directors of VOMI.

IV. Overview of Charter of the Board and Board Structure

Virtual Organization Management Institute
Global Think Tank and Advisory Board Charter
August 1, 2011

Article I. Name and Purpose

The organization shall be known as the Virtual Organization Management Institute (VOMI) Global Think Tank & Advisory Board and shall commonly be referred to as "Think Tank-Advisory Board." The entire VOMI social network community and all members of the Think Tank-Advisory Board shall be known and commonly be referred to as "Main VOMI Membership Body."

The VOMI Think Tank-Advisory Board serves as an advisory committee to the Office of the Chairman on matters pertaining to local, regional, and international issues, events and opportunities. As advisors to the Office of the Chairman, its members provide the sort of global insight and diversity necessary to promote and achieve the mission of VOMI.

Some of these areas include, however, are not limited to:

- Providing advice regarding human and fiscal resources to VOMI.
- Functioning as a global think tank and advocacy group for VOMI.

- Providing deep insight into global cultural issues and local customs.
- Assisting the Chairman and the Executive Committee of VOMI's Board of Directors in strategic planning for VOMI, when appropriate.
- Helping to establish and strengthen relationships with business partners and affiliates.
- Assisting in external public relations and in devising communication strategies for VOMI.
- Assisting in recruitment and retention of fellow advisory board members, corporate board of directors, and executive team.
- Assisting in planning and implementing official events.
- Dealing with other issues as requested by the Office of the Chairman.

Article II. Structure, Function and Responsibilities of the Think Tank-Advisory Board and Its Members

1. Membership

Membership in the Think Tank-Advisory Board shall consist of a maximum of 36 officers (One Chair and One Vice-Chair per committee and subcommittee times a total of 18 committees and subcommittees) and a minimum of 9 regular members per committee and 5 regular members per subcommittee. However, in cases where the need warrants it, the limit is up to 12 regular members per committee and 12 regular members per subcommittee.

The board consists of a total of eight (8) committees and ten (10) subcommittees:

The Global Ambassadors Committee shall consist of officers equally apportioned from the following seven (7) continents and regions: **Europe, Asia, Africa, Middle East, Australia, North America, South America.** In recognition of the contribution of public policy-making friends of VOMI, at least one position on each subcommittee of the Global Ambassadors Committee will be reserved to public policy makers from the 7 continents and regions.

The Think Tank-Advisory Board shall reflect people from varying geographical, racial, cultural and religious backgrounds.

The Chairman of VOMI shall serve as a member ex-officio in a non-voting capacity. This brings the Advisory Board's officer membership total to 37, with 36 members being appointed and or elected and having voting privileges.

2. Specific Member Responsibilities

Each member shall accept the following responsibilities:

- Advise and counsel the Chairman of VOMI as requested.
- Evangelize on VOMI's endeavors and accomplishments whenever possible and appropriate.

- Provide valuable insight on relevant global virtual organization trends and issues to the Chairman of VOMI and Executive Leadership Team.
- Exercise due diligence in the fulfillment of their individual mandate on the board.
- Identify potential and actual individuals, corporations, and foundations able and willing to sponsor VOMI events, fellowships, scholarships, grants, and research activities.
- To help, as appropriate, in the identification, cultivation and solicitation of business partners and affiliates.
- To attend, when appropriate, events sponsored by VOMI.
- To organize and attend meetings of the Think Tank-Advisory Board, including the annual VOMI Global CEO Summit.
- To deal with any and all other issues as requested by the Chairman of VOMI.

3. Executive Committee of the Board of Directors of VOMI

The Executive Committee of the Board of Directors of VOMI (“VOMI Executive Committee”) shall be kept updated and informed of the Think Tank-Advisory Board’s activities and all other VOMI-related events. The VOMI Executive Committee shall meet at least twice a year in order to elect a new Think Tank-Advisory Board.

4. Think Tank-Advisory Board Election

The Think Tank-Advisory Board Election shall take place virtually on a set date, on the first business day of January and July, during California, USA time zone. The Chairperson will decide the election time, after consulting with the VOMI Executive Committee. Think Tank-Advisory Board members must be nominated via e-mail or online to the VOMI Executive Committee before election day. Voting on nominees will take place on election day, and absentee votes will be accepted upon good cause liberally construed.

5. Officers and Their Responsibilities

There are 16 elected officers, 20 appointed officers, up to 12 regular members and up to 12 alternate members per committee. The *elected and **appointed officers shall be:

7 Alternate Members

The term of office is 6 months. Candidates for each officer position shall be nominated by the VOMI Executive Committee and/or a member of the Think Tank-Advisory Board and elected by a majority vote of the Think Tank-Advisory Board and the entire Main VOMI Membership Body.

The Chairman of VOMI Global Think Tank and Advisory Board has the sole authority to make an Interim Appointment to a specific position on the board in order to fill any existing vacancy on an interim basis, pending an upcoming election.

Chairperson

The Chairman of VOMI Global Think Tank & Advisory Board shall have responsibility for general supervision of all its affairs. The Chairman of VOMI shall serve as the interim Chairman of the Think Tank-Advisory Board whenever a vacancy for the chairmanship position exists on the board.

The Chairperson shall preside at all meetings of the membership and carry out the policies established by the membership. In questions of procedure during the meetings, the Chairperson shall follow Robert's Rules of Order with the assistance of a parliamentarian. The Chairperson shall act as the official Think Tank-Advisory Board spokesperson, appoint ad-hoc committees, and call meetings of the membership. The Chairperson is an ex-officio, voting member of all ad-hoc committees. The Chairperson is required to keep the VOMI Executive Committee informed of the Think Tank-Advisory Board's activities. The Chairperson is responsible for maintaining a directory of all VOMI Advisory Board members. The Chairperson coordinates the annual Think Tank-Advisory Board election.

Vice-Chairperson

The Vice-Chairperson shall perform and discharge the duties of the Chairperson in case of his or her absence. He or she shall have general responsibility for programs at regular meetings. He or she shall also perform such duties as the Chairperson may prescribe.

6. Term of Service

Members are elected to the Global Think Tank-Advisory Board for a 6-month term of service, up to a maximum term of 3 years or 6 terms. Members of the VOMI Executive Committee nominate Think Tank-Advisory Board members. The Main VOMI Membership Body votes on nominated members to the Global Think-Tank Advisory Board. The entire 36 seats on the Advisory Board are open for election every 6 months.

7. Meetings

Regular

The Think Tank-Advisory Board meets at least twelve times a year. The number of Think Tank-Advisory Board meetings, and the scheduling of such meetings, will be at the discretion of the Chairperson. The Chairperson will consult with the VOMI Executive Committee of the Board of Directors regarding the number and scheduling of such meetings.

Special

The Chairperson may call a special meeting with reasonable notice.

Voting

Each member of the Think Tank-Advisory Board shall be entitled to one vote. All questions shall be decided by a majority vote of the Board members. The Think Tank-Advisory Board may, in its judgment, approve and arrange for a vote to be taken online or by teleconference, video conference, web conference or e-mail, and may also approve the acceptance of a vote on any issue.
